TITLE: UN-FOLLOW

I want to review in a minute.

1. Everybody is invited to follow.
2. It's an invitation to relationship.
3. The goal is overwhelming faith.
4. Following will eventually cost you something.
5. Are you a follower or consumer?

Tonight, I want to talk to you about "Un-Follow"

We're going to conclude with a very important question.

John 6:66 From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him.

Hit the un-follow button.

Love the miracles.

Love the food.

Love the excitement.

Love the friendships.

The people were done... they had gone as far as they can.

Some were ready to un-follow.

In fact, Jesus asked them the un-follow question.

John 6:67 "You do not want to leave too, do you?" Jesus asked the Twelve.

People don't unusually un-follow because they don't believe, they usually un-follow because it's too hard, it's inconvenient.

John 6:68 Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.

Here's the question: To whom shall we go?

When you choose not to follow Jesus, you choose to follow someone or something else.

If I choose to say no to You, then I'm saying yes to someone else.

Here's the issue: If you ever un-follow Jesus there will come a day in your life you'll wish you could come back and change your mind.

If not Jesus, who?

To whom shall I go? Great question.

Transition, temptation and trouble create questions.

There will always be questions, but it's a mistake to step away from Jesus in these times.

Just because you don't have the answer, doesn't mean there is no answer. You just haven't found it yet.

Settle in your life/spirit, I'm never stepping away. I'm never un-follow Him.

If not Jesus, who? To whom shall I go? Don't ever make a move until you can answer this question.

Salvation is free, it cost you nothing.

Following Christ will cost you something.

Refusing to follow Christ could cost you everything.

Now let me talk to you about Jesus asking you to un-follow some things.

In order to follow Him closer, you may need to un-follow some things in your life.

What about the things that obstruct you from drawing close to Him.

Maybe it's sin.

Maybe it's not.

Maybe it's a void.

There are all kinds of opportunities to hit the un-follow Him.

You're completely in control of the click on the mouse button of life.
