TITLE: CONFIDENCE or GODFIDENCE.

Exodus 14:21-22

21 And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the Lord caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided.

22 And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry ground: and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

Dictionary, Confidence: Full trust; belief in the powers, trustworthiness, or reliability of a person or thing.

Wikipedia: Self-confidence does not necessarily imply "self-belief" or a belief in one's ability to succeed. For instance, one may be inept at a particular sport or activity, but remain "confident" in one's demeanor, simply because one does not place a great deal of emphasis on the outcome of the activity. When one does not dwell on negative consequences one can be more "self-confident" because one is worrying far less about failure or the disapproval of others following potential failure.

Confidence is a natural ability. We are in control of this human ability/emotion.

Moses had Godfidence.

Exodus 9:1

Then the Lord said unto Moses, Go in unto Pharaoh, and tell him, Thus saith the Lord God of the Hebrews, Let my people go, that they may serve me.

We know the 10 plagues followed. But somewhere in the fiber of who Moses was, there was Godfidence.

He was to challenge the president, the prime minister... pharaoh.

Clearly outmatched by human resources. But where Moses excels is with his Godfidence actions.

Exodus 13:21

And the Lord went before them by day in a pillar of a cloud, to lead them the way; and by night in a pillar of fire, to give them light; to go by day and night.

Here again, an uncommon practice. Following clouds.

There will be times that your Godfidence will cause you to act contrary to logic and perhaps even common sense.

It's very possible Godfidence will defy the obvious.

Outside the realm of Godfidence you'll think:

If I do this, it won't work.

There is no way this will happen.

This is impossible.

Stand up and speak up what God has shown you. Do not be intimidated by what you see.

Profess and declare your Godfidence with assurance.

Godfidence is the supernatural ability. It's your belief and trust in the spoken Word.

Stand at your red sea and speak into the atmosphere with Godfidence.

Mark 11:23

For verily I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Get bold.

Get aggressive.

Get ready.

Get Godfidence.
