TITLE: SILENT KILLER (Part II)

Romans 12:19 -NLT

Dear friends, never take revenge. Leave that to the righteous anger of God. For the Scriptures say, "I will take revenge; I will pay them back," says the Lord.

It is righteous for God to avenge His servants. It is unrighteous for God's servants to avenge themselves.

Saul avenged himself. HE chased David for 14yrs.

David stood over Saul while he was sleeping. His actions were an expression of his heart.

David waited on a righteous God to avenge.

When you don't address conflict, you usually leave offended. (SILENT KILLER)

Offenses don't fix themselves.....You have to fix them.

Changing churches doesn't fix them.

Pouting doesn't fix them.

A critical spirit doesn't change them.

People that leave this way think churches are cafeterias.

Pick and choose, come, and go.

1 Corinthians 12:18 -NLT

But our bodies have many parts, and God has put each part just where he wants it.

IF you're in the place where God wants you, the Devil will try to offend you to get you out. (SILENT KILLER)
